**MEETING MINUTES**

**1. Open and Welcome Remarks**

APDSC Treasurer cum APDSC Football Technical Director for the Asia Pacific Deaf Football Qualifying Rounds, Mr. Lim Heng Tuck, started the meeting at around 1705hrs and welcomed everyone who joined the video conference.

He invited the APDSC President, Mr. Mohammad Pargar who have joined the video conference to give a welcome speech but the internet connection failed and Mr. Mohammad Pargar got disconnected. Mr. Lim instead invited APDSC Acting Secretary-General, Mr. Enkhbayar Janchivnyambuu to give a welcome speech.

### 3. Presentation and Explanations of Technical Rules

- Mr. Lim briefed all countries about the Football Technical Regulations.
- Mr. Lim explained that the Names for the Technical / Protest Committee and also the Venue Names in the Technical Regulations are still pending from Local Organizing Committee.
- Mr. Lim informed that the confirmed participations are Five (05) Countries. I.R. Iran, Iraq, Korea, Malaysia and Thailand. Up to date, Uzbekistan and Afghanistan still haven't submitted their finalized Form 2.
- The teams placing draw will be made in Kish Island, Iran.
- Discussed about the number of substitutions that may be made during a match. According to the existing technical rules it is stated as a maximum of 3, however, recently FIFA made a temporary amendment to their technical rules allowing up to 5 substitution due to the Covid-19 outbreak. Mr. Lim asked for the decisions to be voted. Results as per below:
  - Afghanistan : -
  - I.R. Iran : 5 Substitutions
  - Iraq : 5 Substitutions
  - Korea : 3 Substitutions
  - Malaysia : 5 Substitutions
  - Thailand : 3 Substitutions
  - Uzbekistan : -
  - Actions : To be discussed further during the team draw meeting in Kish Island.
- Mr. Lim requested for all countries to send him a photo of their Home and Away Jerseys including the keeper's uniform. He also explained about the sizes of logos and emblems allowed on the jerseys.
- Qualification team to Deaflympics Brazil 2022. There's confusion either the top Three (03) or Four (04) places are qualified to the Deaflympics Brazil. Mr. Lim informed that he had already emailed the ICSD CEO regarding this matter and still pending responses. Mr. Pargar will follow up and inform the teams about the results.
  - Actions : Mr. Pargar to follow up.
- Video Recording during the match for protests. Local Organizing Committee informed that the video recording is not available during group stages. Only available during Semi-finals and Finals. Mr. Pargar explained that he is working on this to get coverage for all matches
  - Actions :Mr. Pargar to follow up.

#### 4. Questions and Discussions

- Malaysia questioned if the Football Technical Director for the Qualifying Rounds are certified TD Officer
  - Mr. Lim informed that APDSC Executive Committee elected him as the representative and also Football Technical Director for neutral standings as the current APDSC Football Technical Director are actually from I.R. Iran.
- Korea questioned if the NDSO's logo emblem are allowed on the jerseys.
  - Mr. Lim explained that the NDSO's logo emblem are allowed.
- Uzbekistan questioned about the credibility of the Referee and also the nationalities of the Referees for neutral standings.
  - Mr. Massod from the I.R. Iran explained that the Referees are AFC certified referees, however, due to the Covid-19 outbreak, the OC are not able to get other nationalities Referees.
- Malaysia questioned about the outstanding payments of APDSC Membership Fees and other outstanding fees.
  - Mr. Lim explained that in accordance to the APDSC Constitutions, in order for the NDSO to attend the APDSC organized events and congress, all outstanding fees must be cleared before they're allowed to participate. Hence, Mr. Lim reminded all countries that all the outstanding fees must be cleared either by Wire Transfer or pay in Cash upon arrival in Kish Island, Iran.
  - Mr. Lim have already emailed the invoices of outstanding to all countries.
  - All countries accepted this notion and expressed the understandings.

#### 5. Closing Remark

APDSC Treasurer cum APDSC Football Technical Director for the Asia Pacific Deaf Football Qualifying Rounds, Mr. Lim Heng Tuck, declared that the Technical Regulations meeting closed at 1815hrs. He thanked all countries for participating in the video conference. He also reminded Afghanistan and Uzbekistan to send in their Form 2 as soon as possible.
